They learnt about how the warehouse operates and who can use a foodbank. Everyone worked hard and learned volunteering is very rewarding.

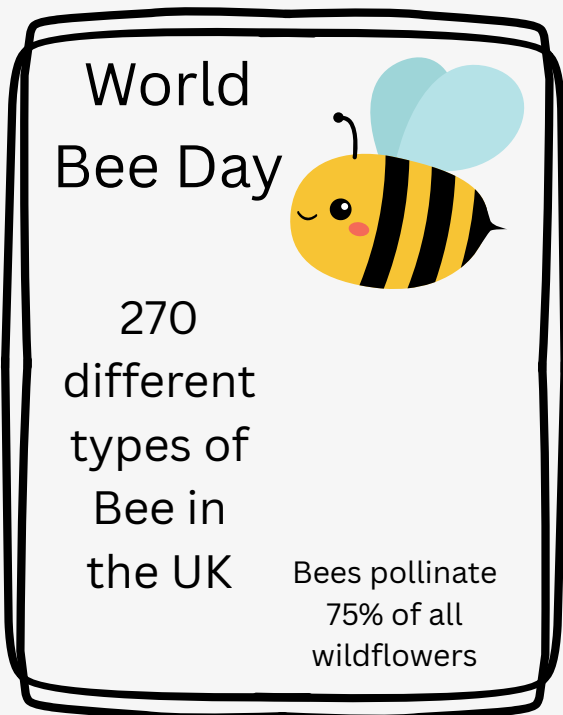
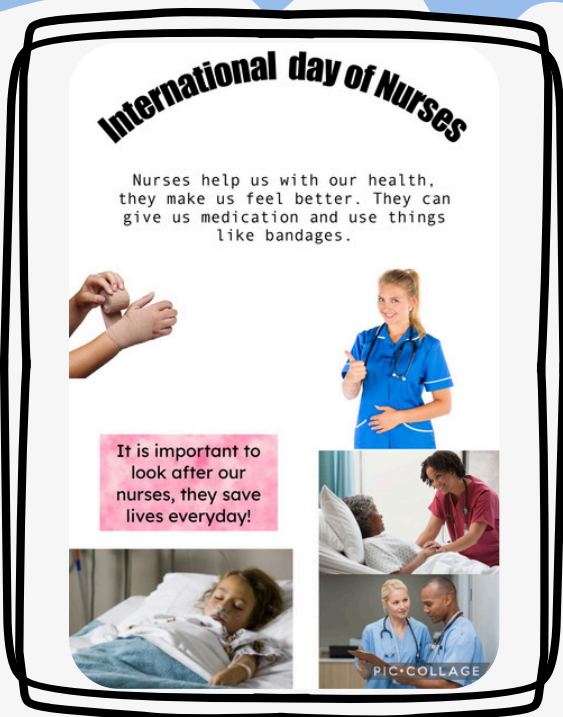

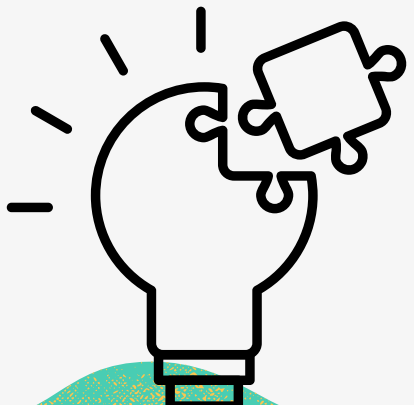




Careers

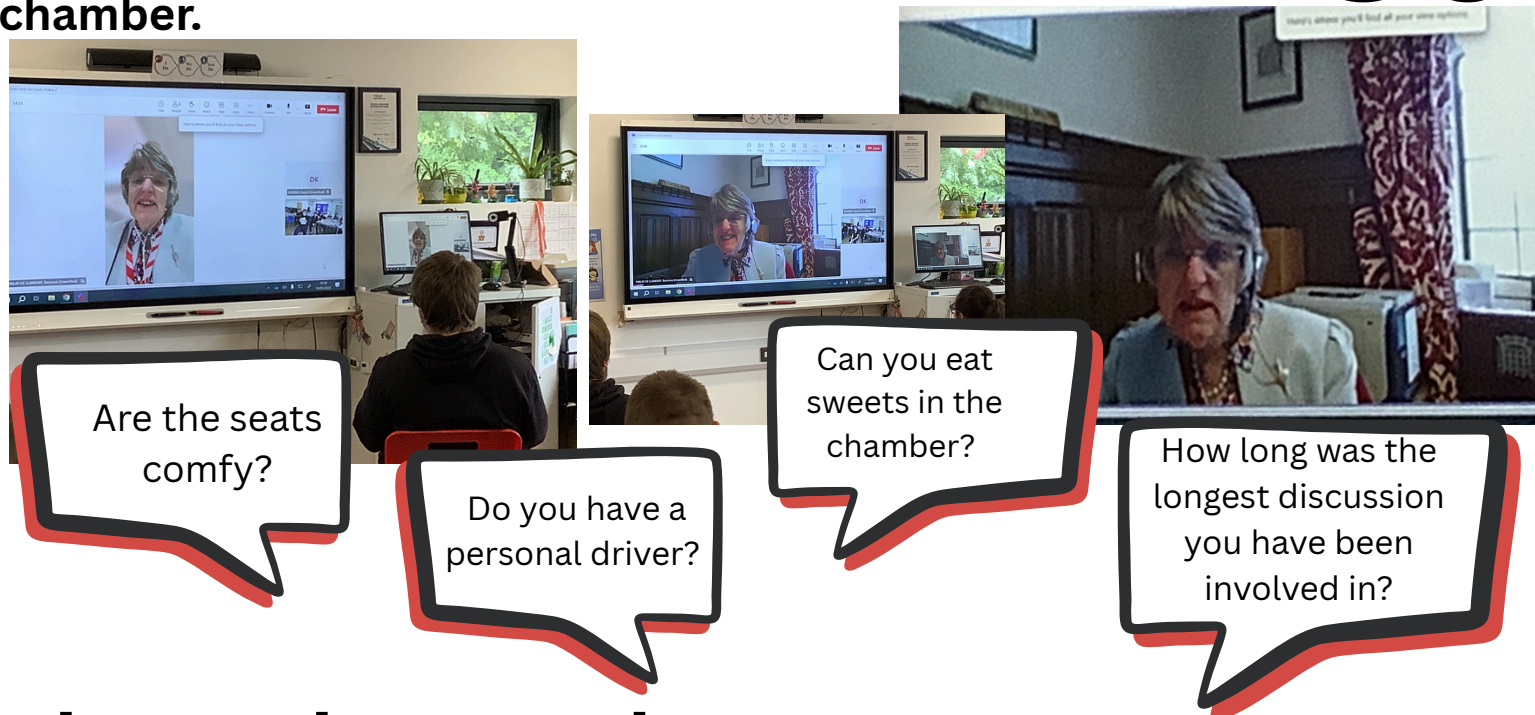
Learn with the Lords
